4/8 Mon	Assemble at HK Airport at 12:30 pm for 4:15pm flight. Upon arrival (flying time 11.20hours) proceed to check in hotel in Tel Aviv .	Jaffa
5/8 Tue	<u>Morning:</u> After early breakfast, visit Jaffa Port (Joppa) , where Jonah sailed to Nineveh. Go to the house of Simon the Tanner where Peter was given a vision from heaven (Acts 10). Afterwards, we visit Diaspora Museum to learn the unique but sad history of the worldwide scattering of the Jewish people. <u>Afternoon:</u> After lunch, visit Neot Kedumin - a biblical landscape reserve park to learn the natural species of the land of Israel. Afterwards, Tour with ICEJ Director of Christian Desk the outlying garden of Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Museum , where cacao trees are planted in honor of righteous Gentiles during the Holocaust. This is a rare opportunity to sponsor a tree upkeep. Overnight stay Jerusalem	Jerusalem
6/8 Wed	<u>Morning:</u> , the first spot to visit is the Temple Mount , the very location where the Temple stood for 1000 years, then to the Temple Institute , to study the components and furnishings of the Temple in Old Testament times. Learn the mystery of the Aaronic priests presently preparing to re-build the third Temple. After that, then to Burnt House to re-visit the scene of the destruction of the second Temple by the Roman soldiers in 70 AD.	Jerusalem

	<p><i>Afternoon:</i> After lunch, we explore the Western Wall Tunnel enlarged by Herod, located some 150 feet underneath the wailing wall. Pray at the place closest to the Holy of Holies.</p> <p>We visit Israel Museum, to learn of the shrine of the books which houses the Dead Sea Scroll and the model of the second temple.</p>	
7/8 Thur	<p><i>Morning:</i> Explore the Jewish quarter and pray at the Wailing Wall. Go to the Upper Room and David's Tomb, then proceed to St Peter en Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus 3 times. (Mark 14: 30, 53-72).</p> <p><i>Afternoon:</i> After lunch, ascend the Mount of Olive for a panoramic view of the magnificent Temple Mount and Old City, we then proclaim Isaiah 52:7</p> <p>How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!" Visit Dominus Flevit (Latin for "The Lord Wept") atop the Mount, believed to be the place where Jesus wept over the tragic events that would befall Jerusalem after His ascension. (Luke 19:37-42). Walk the path of Jesus on passion week and meditate at the Garden of Gethsemane. Trace the stations of the Via Dolorosa (The way of suffering-believed to be the path Jesus took on the way to the cross). We end the day at Garden Tomb, believed to be Golgotha and nearby empty tomb where Jesus was crucified and buried. We will worship and take Holy Communion.</p>	Jerusalem
8/8 Fri	<p><i>Morning:</i> Go to Shiloh, where the tabernacle and the Ark of the covenant was placed for 390 years. Visit the cave house of the Priest Eli and discover the amazing archaeological findings of the area.</p> <p><i>Afternoon:</i> We drive on to Bethlehem, visit the Church of Nativity of Bethlehem in manger square, believed to be the birthplace of Jesus. We will gather at the Shepherd's Field and pray for the single ladies at the threshing floor where Ruth met Boaz. Then we go to Qumran to learn the culture and life of the Essenes in the time of Jesus.</p>	Jerusalem
9/8 Sat	<p><i>Morning:</i> Baptism at the Jordan River of AL-Ehud where it is believed to be the actual place of Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist. Drive on to Jericho, to visit the ruins of the Fallen Walls of Jericho, stop by Elisha spring fountain where it is believed Elisha healed the bitter water (2 Kings 2:21). We will share and gather to pray at the tree of Zacchaeus.</p> <p><i>Afternoon:</i> Visit the Ahava factory then float on the Dead Sea. We then drive north on the Jordan Valley Road towards the Sea of Galilee, we will drop by a kibbutz in Gilgal en route to Tiberias. Shop in the Galilee Experience before checking in to hotel in Tiberias.</p>	Tiberias
10/8 Sun	<p><i>Morning:</i> After early breakfast we drive to Capernaum, then, Mt of Beatitudes for worship and sharing., and St Peter's Primacy, then St Peter's fish lunch.</p> <p><i>Afternoon:</i> After St Peter's fish lunch, We drive up the Jordan Valley Road to Afula, there we will visit a home for abandoned children 'Children in crisis' from age 5-16. We will bring gifts to the children that are of daily necessity.</p>	Tiberias
11/8 Mon	<p><i>Morning:</i> Visit Haifa's Holocaust Survivor's Home funded and built by ICEJ Germany. We will share the love of Christ by singing songs and comfort the elderly residents. Then we proceed to Muhraka in Mt Carmel, believed to be the site where Elijah defeated the Baals. Lunch at Mediterranean seaside restaurant in Caesaria,</p> <p><i>Afternoon:</i> After lunch, then see the excavated ruins of Herod's palace, the amphitheater etc, before heading to the Tel Aviv airport for the flight home Flight depart 8pm for Hong Kong, flying time 10.20 hours.</p>	On the plane
