22 SEPTEMBER (SAT)

1. Assemble at 4pm for 830pm flight (LY78) at HK International Airport check in Zone H. Upon arrival at 3:40am local time (flying time 11:40 hour) in Tel Aviv we proceed to Neot Kudumim for an early breakfast



23 SEPTEMBER (SUN)

1. After our guided tour of the biblical landscape reserve of Neot Kudumim, we proceed on to Jerusalem.
2. We drive through Chapel of the Ascension, and ascend the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of the magnificent Old City. We will proclaim and declare Isaiah 52:7.
3. Next, visit the Dominus Flevit Church (Latin for "The Lord Wept") atop the Mount, believed to be the place where Jesus wept over the tragic events that would occur in Jerusalem after His ascension. (Luke 19:41-44)
4. Then, we descend the foothills of the Mount to meditate at the Garden of Gethsemane. (Mathew 26:36-46, Luke 22:39-48). Pastor would preach a message of Jesus' sorrow and agony before the cross and we will pray and receive in this place.
5. We check in and have lunch at the hotel.
6. We set out for the Feast of Tabernacles Desert Celebration on the sea shore of the Dead Sea at Ein Gedi Spa. This is an evening of extravagant worship, Hebrew dancing and powerful preaching of the Word.



24 SEPTEMBER (MON)

1. We start the day joining the ICEJ Feast pilgrims at the Garden Tomb, where by the empty tomb, we raise up our voice in praise and worship the risen Christ. We will listen to a powerful preaching of the word on living "resurrection life" for Jesus, and partake of the Holy Communion with 2000 believers.
2. We go to Mount Zion to the Upper Room. We will pray for the power and fire of the Holy Spirit to bring revival to the land. Proceed to the Church of St. Peter en Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus 3 times (Mark 14:30, 53-65). Rev Colin will share a message, and lead us to





confess. Then, we will pray for the revival of our spiritual life.

3. At this very site where Peter denied Jesus 3 times and just before Jesus was taken to the cross, we will do a prophetic prayer proclamation for **1. the tribe of Benjamin** declaring their return to the land.
4. Back to hotel for dinner.
5. Evening, we go to **ICEJ Conference Celebration** at **Pais Arena** Highlight of Open Ceremony: Parade of the Nations. Our Hong Kong team will assign representatives from China, Hong Kong and Malaysia to go on stage bearing their respective countries' national flags.



25 SEPTEMBER (TUE)

1. After breakfast, we go to visit the **Temple Mount**, the very location where the Temple stood for 1000 years, experience how Abraham felt when he offered Isaac as a sacrifice to the Lord (Genesis 22:1-18).
2. Walk the **Western Wall Tunnel** underneath the Temple Mount, believed to be the closest place to the Holy of Holies.
3. Then we go to the **Wailing Wall**. Pray at the place closest to the Holy of Holies.
4. After breakfast, we drive to **Bethel**, House of God, the place where Abraham built an altar to God and also the place where Jacob saw the heavenly ladder. We do a prayer walk proclamation of the anointing of the land possession for **2. the tribe of Ephraim**.
5. After dinner, we join in **ICEJ Conference Celebration**



26 SEPTEMBER (WED)

1. **ICEJ Conference** morning Seminars and Message at **Pais Arena**.
2. Afternoon free time (no lunch).
3. **ICEJ Conference** evening Celebration at **Pais Arena**.

27 SEPTEMBER (THURS)

1. **ICEJ Conference** morning Seminars and Message at **Pais Arena**.
2. In the afternoon, highlight of Feast of Tabernacles: **Jerusalem March**, A colorful parade of the nations declaring solidarity with Israel and Jerusalem. No lunch provided.
3. **ICEJ Conference** Israeli Guest Night evening Celebration at **Pais Arena**.

28 SEPTEMBER (FRI)

1. **City of David** tour. Ruins of the ancient palace. Video of David's capture of the Jebusite fortress of Mount Zion to later become the City of David
2. Then we proceed to the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus healed a man crippled for 38 years (John 5:1-14).
3. Walk the stations of the **Via Dolorosa** (The way of Suffering, believed to be the path Jesus took on the way to the cross).
4. Then we proceed to the **Davidson Archaeological Site** near the Western Wall, to reflect back on the days of Jesus' pilgrimage.
5. We go to visit the **Church of Nativity**, believed to be the place where Jesus was born..
6. Then we will gather at the **Shepherd's Field** and pray for the single men and women at the threshing floor where Ruth met Boaz.

29 SEPTEMBER (SAT)

1. Drive to **Hebron** to visit the **Cave of the Patriarchs**. Visit the synagogue inside the tomb. Preaching and proclamation at the great **Tree of Mamre** (Gen 8:1-2) where Abraham was confirmed the birth of Isaac. We will do a prophetic prayer proclamation for **3. the tribe of Judah** declaring their (spiritual) return to the land.
2. Float on the **Dead Sea**.





3. Then we stop by **Jericho** at the foot of the Mount of Temptation. Proceed to the **Tree of Zacchaeus**, believed to be the place the tax collector Zacchaeus met with Jesus and be saved. (Luke 19:1-10)
4. We drive across the Judean wilderness to **Qumran**, where the 2000 year old Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947.
5. We will go to **Ariel** to visit the full scale replica of the tabernacle.
6. We will go to **Mount Gerizim** and do a prayer walk proclamation of the anointing of the land possession for **5. the tribe of Manasseh**
7. Overnight at **Nazareth Rimomium**.

30 SEPTEMBER (SUN)

1. After early breakfast we go to **Mount Tabor**. We do a prayer walk proclamation of the anointing of the possession for **6. the tribe of Issachar** at the foot of **Mount Tabor**. We will pray for the anointing of discerning and understanding the times.
2. Driving through the Jordan Valley to **En Harod**, the spring where Gideon and his 300 warriors defeated the Midianites. We pray for the anointing of the remnant of the 300 Israeli warriors.
3. Next, we go to visit ICEJ funded **Haifa Holocaust Survivor's Home** to meet and sing for the elderly residents. We will take a Christian love offering for the daily operation of the Home.
4. Then proceed to **Muhraka** in Mount Carmel. It is the altar of Elijah where he defeated the Baal. Here we pray for Elijah's anointing of miracles and victory. Then, we do a prayer walk proclamation of the anointing of the land possession for **7. the tribe of Asher**.
5. Overnight at **Nazareth Rimomium**.

1 OCTOBER (MON)

1. After early breakfast we drive north to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Jesus declared "On this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it" (Matthew 16:13-18).
2. We will go to the land of **Dan**. We do a prayer walk proclamation of the anointing of the land possession for **8. the tribe of Dan** at **the Dan River**.
3. Drive to **Megiddo**, take a breathtaking view of the Jezreel Valley and ancient ruins of Tel Megiddo.
4. Visit the **Church of Annunciation** where Gabriel announced the virgin birth. We do a prayer walk proclamation of the anointing of the possession for **9. the tribe of Zebulun**.
5. Then, we go to **Nazareth Village** to get a glimpse of the real life childhood of Jesus in Nazareth, the poor village of 2000 years ago.
6. Then we proceed to **Cana**, long revered as the site of Jesus' first miracle, turning water into wine at a wedding.
7. Overnight at **Nazareth Rimomium**.

2 OCTOBER (TUE)

1. After breakfast, drive to the **Mount of Beatitudes** to worship the Lord. Rev Colin will preach a message about the blessings of the Beatitudes.
2. Then we go to the **Church of St Peter's Primacy**, this is where the resurrected Jesus showed Himself to His disciples and especially the place where Jesus reinstated Peter (John 21: 16-20).
3. St. Peter fish lunch followed by a boat ride in the sea of Galilee.
4. Visit **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' Galilee Ministry (Matthew 4:13). Here we do a prayer walk proclamation of the anointing of the land possession for **10. the tribe of Naphtali**.
5. We proceed to the **Jordan River** and have a baptismal service at Yardenit.



3 OCTOBER (WED)

1. Visit **Caesarea Maritima** by the sea and view the ruin of the Roman Amphitheater and the ruin of Herod's Palace.
2. Drive south to Tel Aviv & proceed to **Rabin Square**, a memorial for the assassination of Prime Minister of Israel, Yitzhak Rabin in 1995.
3. Proceed to the ancient **Jaffa Port**. We spend some prayer time at Simon Peter's house, where Peter raised Dorcas (Acts 9:36) to life in the house of Simon the Tanner (Acts 10:6).
4. Take a magnificent view of the Mediterranean Sea.
5. Lunch (**Four Seas Restaurant**).
6. Heading to the airport for the flight (LY75) back to Hong Kong, overnight on plane.
